The Mayor and Administrator be and they are hereby authorized for and on behalf of the Municipality to execute, under the seal of the Municipality, and to deliver to SUMAssure Insurance Reciprocal the subscription form appended as Schedule "A" to the Reciprocal Agreement, and to do all such other things as may be necessary or required to complete such subscription.
- 3. The Administrator be and is hereby authorized to determine and obtain coverage for such of the classes of insurance as are offered by SUMAssure Insurance Reciprocal under and pursuant to the Reciprocal Agreement.
- 4. The payment of the Annual Subscription Charge for the first year of participation in SUMAssure Insurance Reciprocal and the premiums for coverage under the classes of insurance to be obtained from and through SUMAssure Insurance Reciprocal be and the same are hereby approved.
