## **Pets:**

- Please be mindful of you neighbors & as noted in the bylaw: *-No person shall allow their dog to **bark excessively** this is in violation of the Animal Control Bylaw and subject to fines.*
- If a domestic pet defecates on any public or private property it shall be removed immediately, by owner, possessor or harbourer of the domestic animal and disposed of in a sanitary fashion, failure to do so is subject to penalties.
- Annual registration fees: \$10.00 for each female, \$5.00 for each spayed female, \$5.00 for each male.
- No person shall allow their domestic pet(s) to be at large within the Village without being restrained by leash or harness.
- Owners should ensure that their domestic pet(s) remains on their property by either the means of leash, harness or adequate enclosure.
