# Healthy Lifestyles

## This month we concentrate on

### Personal Hygiene

It has been a pleasure for all of us to enjoy the glorious sunshine and increased temperatures over the past few weeks. As the children continue to grow and develop, we must consider the personal hygiene of our pupils. Moving forward, we would encourage all children in grades 6-12 to begin to use deodorant.

#### **Why does my child need to wear deodorant?**

As children begin puberty, a lot of them start to develop body odor. Different children start puberty at different times, but puberty usually begins between the ages of 8-14.

#### **How is deodorant useful?**

Deodorants get rid of the odor of sweat by covering it up, and antiperspirants stops or dries up that perspiration. There's no specific age at which children can start using it, but they should read and follow the directions. Some deodorants work better if they're used at night, while others recommend application in the morning.

#### **How can I encourage good personal hygiene?**

Encourage your child to get into the habit of showering every day. They also might want to shower after activities where they worked up a sweat. Encourage them to wear clean clothes, socks, and underwear each day.


