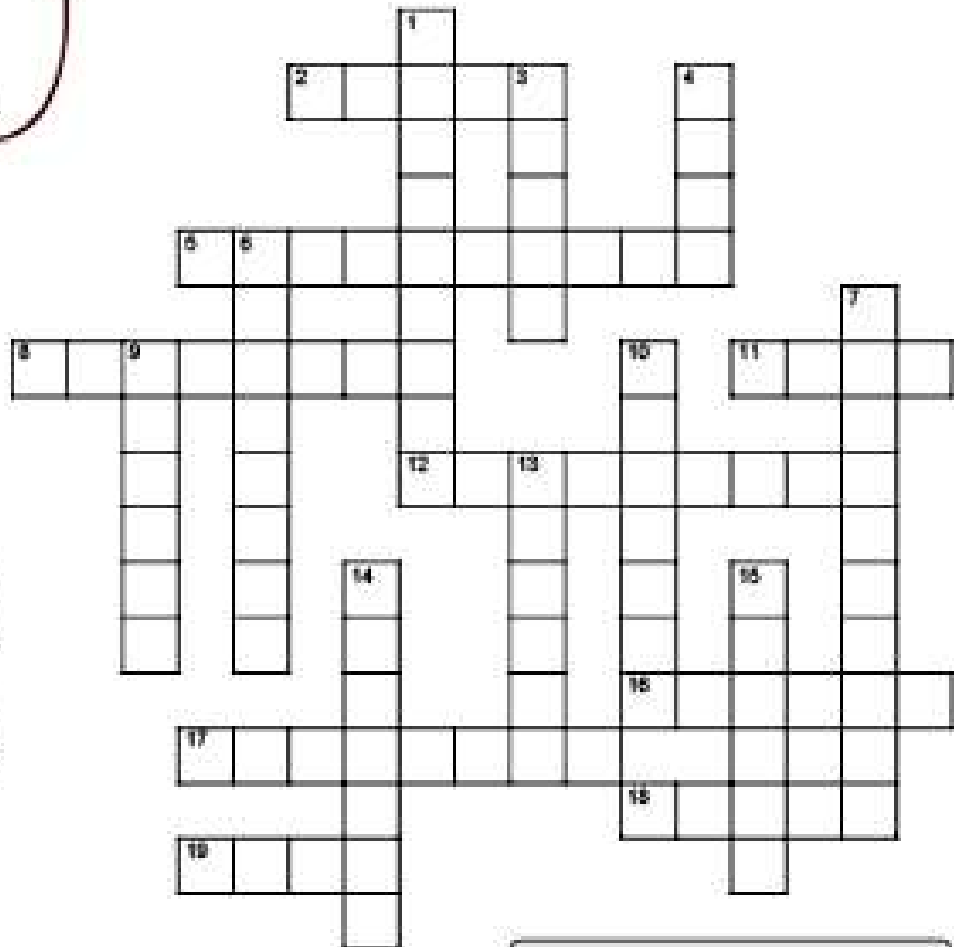

How to brush

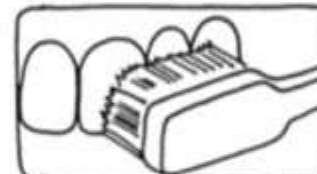
Use a soft toothbrush- the kind your dentist and hygienist tell you to use.
