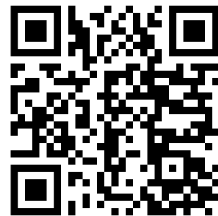
Message from School Administration

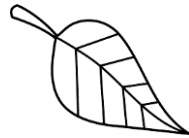
