WATERWORKS RATE POLICY

On April 16, 2025, Council passed Bylaw 1/2025 to fix the rates to be charged for the use and consumption of water and to fix the rates to be charged for the use of the sewer, noting the bylaw notes no changes to the infrastructure fee of \$10.00 a month for water & \$10.00 a month for sewer as reserve for future infrastructure upgrades.

The objective of the Waterworks rate policy is to have waterworks be a self-financing entity of the municipality. Revenue covering the operating costs, plus amortization, depreciation and accretion of asset retirement obligations which is basically replacing retired infrastructure.

WATERWORKS CAPITAL INVESTMENT STRATEGY

To cover the costs of future waterworks infrastructure maintenance and replacements, Council will be analyzing revenues and expenses of Utilities to build the waterworks reserves in 2026. To ensure a savings is in place, a monthly transfer of \$4000 to a Flex GIC clearly marked for future waterworks capital infrastructure. The capital investment strategy will ensure that safe drinking water can be provided to the residents, businesses, and surrounding rural communities in the present and future.

A Five Year Capital plan is being developed, in conjunction with Asset Management, to strategize the replacement and repairs of sewer and water infrastructure, including and not limited to replacement of the main water line from the Well to the WTP, replacement of isolation valves, fire hydrants, curb stops and replacement of water & sewer lines.

Majority of the upgrades funded by Canada Community-Building Fund grant (formerly Gas Tax Program), were completed in 2025. upgrades included: Installation and integrated Xylem VFD to new submersible pump- tie into twin VFD on site of Lead lag control and integration into HMI for on status; installation of submersible pump with new tie into distribution header.
