The Canadian Dental Care Plan is now available to all eligible Canadians

Assistance with the online or renewal applications will be available onsite.

What you need to apply

You'll need to provide the following information for each applicant, and your spouse or common-law partner (if you have one):

- Social Insurance Number (SIN) (if available for children)
- date of birth
- full name
- home and mailing address
- list of dental coverage through government social programs (if applicable)
- you and your spouse or common-law partner (if applicable) must have filed your tax return in Canada for the previous year and have received your notice of assessment

Note: Seniors aged 65 and above, adults with a valid Disability Tax Credit certificate for 2023 and children under 18 who apply up to April 30, 2025, need to renew their coverage before June 1, 2025, in order to maintain coverage for the 2025 to 2026 period.
